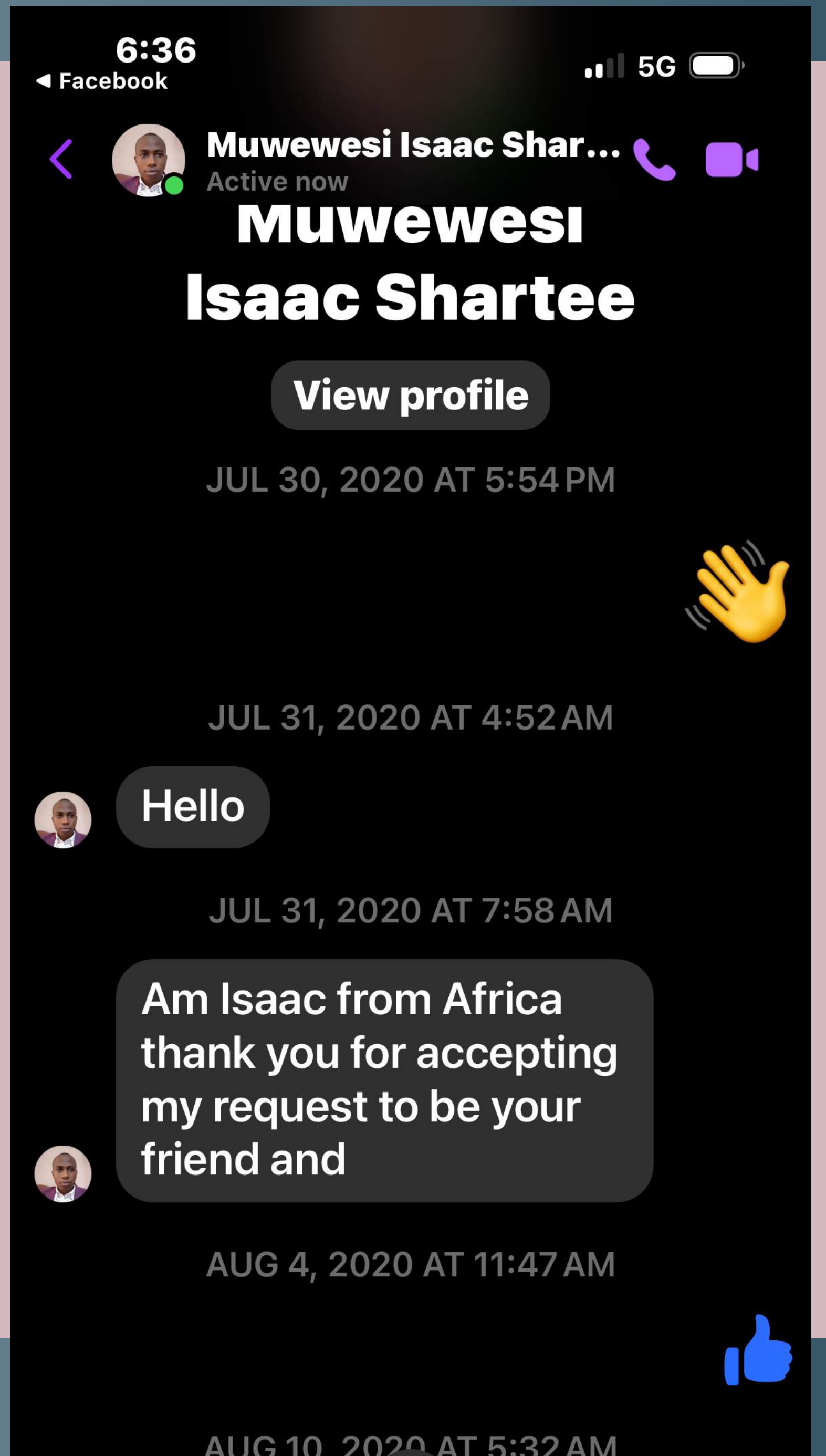

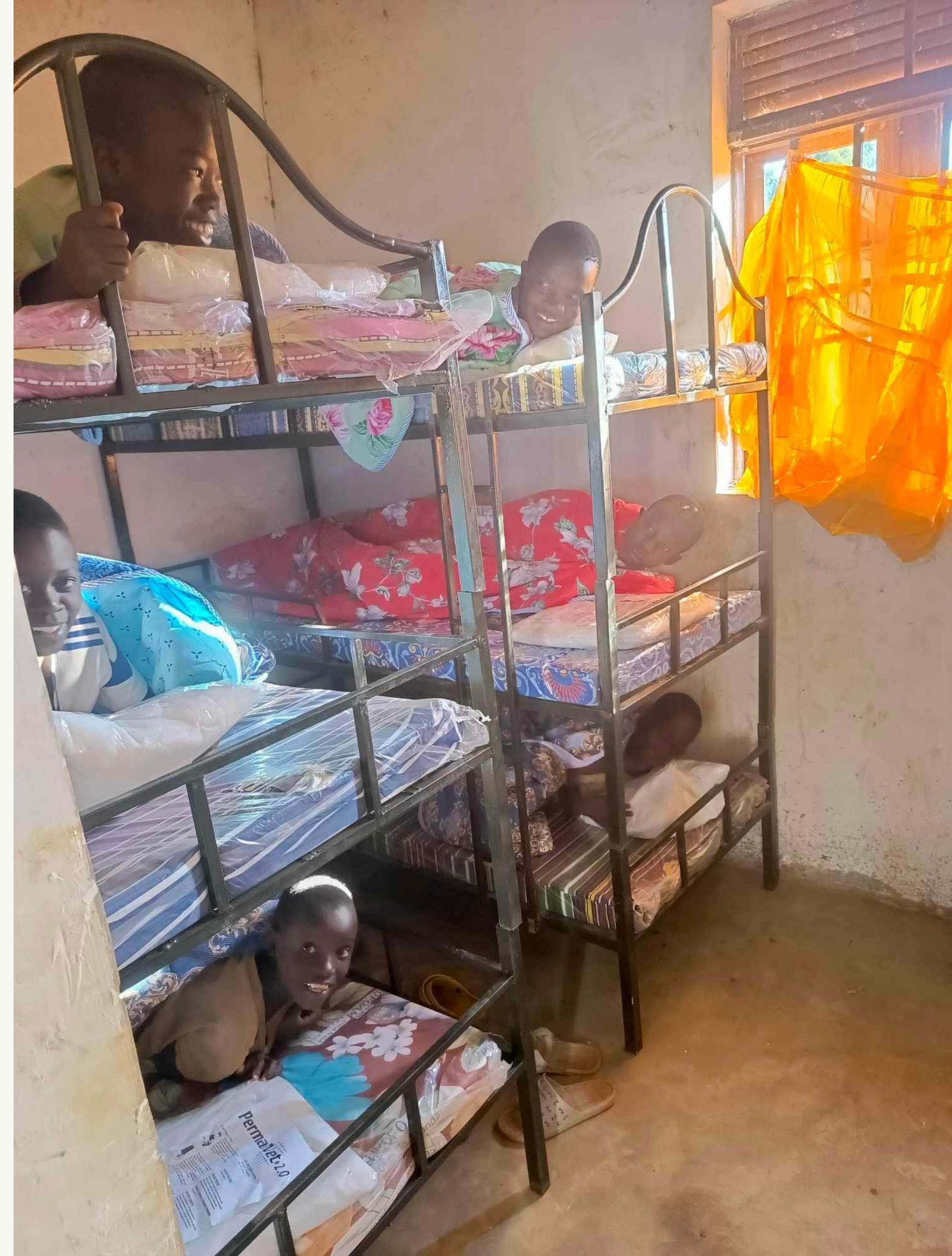

In January I had the chance to go visit with Pastor Isaac and see his church, community, and the amazing children he cares for. Over the last 20 years I've had similar opportunities to visit many communities throughout the developing world, in Africa, Asia, and Central America. One common thing I see is the lack of resources these communities have in relation to communities in the United States. But many communities on a world wide scale are doing pretty good. They can fully provide for the basic needs that they have without support from the West.

Pastor Isaac's community can not fully support the needs of their kids. Don't get me wrong, many needs can be met. There are around 100 orphans in the area. Many of these children have lost one or both parents to Leporsy, Malaria, or other tropical diseases. Pastor Isaac and the community can meet these kids needs by showing them love, providing a safe shelter to sleep, food, and the basic needs of life.

One of the most difficult aspects in the life of these orphans that needs outside assistance is education. Many of these children can not afford the school fees or even have a school in close enough walking distance.

This is where the partnership between He is Worthy and Great Love Junior Academy comes into play. Through the vision of Pastor Isaac, and Max and Vicki Alston, these kids now have a place to go to school.

When I visited, I saw a loving church, a loving community, and a group of believers that trully cared for the orphans in their care. I saw a need. But i saw a community that seeks God to supply all their needs. And I see the potential this community has to trully make a differemce in these kids lives, both spiritually and educationally. I can fully reccommend and endorse Great Love Junior Academy and He is Worthy as a good around to sow your

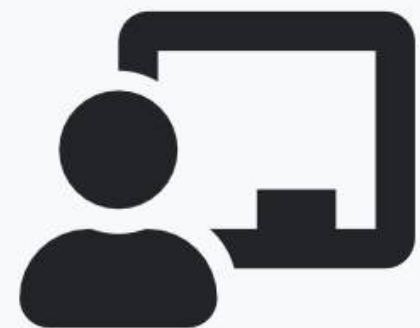

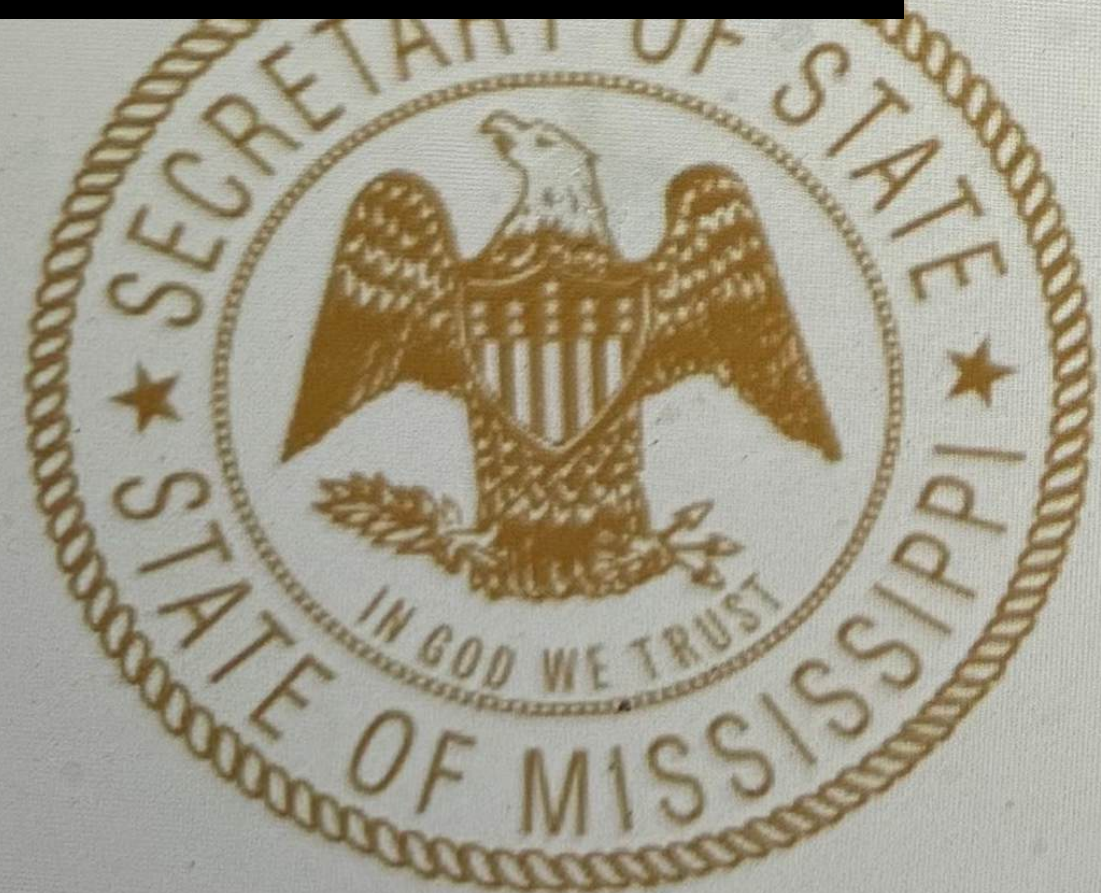

Isaac has a heart for the lepers and wants to minister to them. His parents were lepers. We discussed the cost and it was overwhelming, over \$15k for treatment for 6 months. I told him let's pray. About a week later the governor came to him and provided \$12.5k we put up another \$3k to get all 350 treated for a full year. God took care of our need.
