WHAT YOUR GIVING DID



Mark, 10, and Solomon, 11, the day they were fitted, at Father's Heart Mobility Ministry in Kampala — with their caregivers, and with Pastor Isaac Muwewesi, Enock Nkulanga and George Musoke, who made the journey with them.

WHY THE FITTING MATTERED

These are not the folding chairs that get donated by the container-load and leave a child slumped sideways and sore within an hour. Mark's and Solomon's chairs have **supportive seating, head support and a tray**, measured to each boy. A tray means a child can eat at his own chair, hold something, do school work. A chair that fits is the difference between being moved around and being able to sit up in the world.

A wheelchair is the difference between one room and the world outside it.

This is what the giving actually looks like. No office in the middle of it, no program staff, no overhead. A need, a phone call from a friend in Kampala, two men and a long drive, and a gift to a Ugandan ministry that already knew how to do the work properly. Mark and Solomon are not students at our school. We helped because the need was in front of us and it was within our power to meet it.

Two Boys Got Wheels

Neither of them could walk. Their caregivers had been carrying them.

Not carrying them once. Carrying them — to the latrine, to a neighbor's, anywhere either boy needed to be. That is what happens when a child cannot walk and there is no chair. The world shrinks to the size of one room.

HOW IT HAPPENED

1 We saw the need.

Two boys, and two caregivers doing the carrying.

2 Enock made the call.

He found **Father's Heart Mobility Ministry** in Kampala — people who fit wheelchairs to the child rather than handing out whatever is in the store room.

3 George and Isaac drove them.

George Musoke and Pastor Isaac brought both boys and their caregivers **three hours** to Kampala, and back again, so the boys could be measured and fitted in person.

4 We gave to the ministry.

He Is Worthy donated to Father's Heart. The chairs came out of that gift.

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
